- This is the first time that SSANZ will run combined Advanced/Excellent trials. While we hope that the trial will run quickly and smoothly, please be patient as we all get to grips with this new format.
- The Advanced/ Excellent trials also involves a number of judges who are being mentored for their development. Mentoring and the development of our judges is an investment in the future of SSANZ trials. Please understand that this may lead to a slightly delayed start.
- Please see your respective maps for information on parking.
- Do not allow your dog to “mark” on posts, bins, buildings, vehicles and equipment around the venue. It is a privilege to be allowed to use the venue for our sport and we want to be able to use it again in the future.
- Toilets facilities may not be available while some searches are happening.
- There will be no catering or coffee carts, please come prepared with food and drink.
- To ensure the show runs smoothly, please check in at the call board and keep an eye on who is in front of you.
- Remember to give all dogs and handlers plenty of space; we all like our personal bubble. **If your dog is “spicy”, please collect an orange ribbon and put this somewhere visible on their gear. Thank you.**
- Pukete school grounds are regularly used be used by members of the public. In order to ensure everyone’s safety, any searches conducted outdoors at Pukete must be completed on lead.
- There will be no additional training runs.
- Recording of searches via body worn technology is permitted. Please ask the judge(s) if you would like a friend to come through to video your run(s). SSANZ Photography Guidelines can be found under “files” on the website or via [this link](#).
- We have some volunteer videographers attending. If they are present at your search and you would like to be recorded, please bring your own device to the search for them to use.
- **Do not discuss your search with others until everyone has completed that search, you have no idea how far your voice may travel and influence others.**
